SECOND READING

SB 5666 Schwertner
Relating to eligibility for a loan under the disaster recovery loan program.

SB 5667 Schwertner
Relating to the state historic sites and parks under the jurisdiction of the Texas Historical Commission.

SB 5668 Schwertner
Proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature to provide for an exemption from ad valorem taxation by a school district of a portion, expressed as a dollar amount, of the market value of the residence homestead of a person whose child was home-schooled or enrolled in a private school during the preceding ad valorem tax year.

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTIONS
SECOND READING

SJR 5666 Schwertner
Proposing a constitutional amendment providing that members of the legislature are not entitled to receive a state salary, per diem, or reimbursement for mileage for an unexcused absence when the applicable house of the legislature lacks a quorum.

SJR 5667 Schwertner
Proposing a constitutional amendment to increase the maximum amount of the local option residence homestead exemption from ad valorem taxation by a political subdivision.

SJR 5668 Schwertner
Proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the governing body of a political subdivision other than a school district to adopt an exemption from ad valorem taxation of a portion, expressed as a dollar amount, of the market value of an individual's residence homestead.

HB 20 Schaefer / Allison / et al.
Relating to measures to ensure the safety and welfare of the southern border region of this state, including protection from ongoing criminal activity and public health threats; creating a criminal offense; creating a civil penalty.

HB 5666 Representative
Relating to the powers and duties, authority to issue bonds, and authority to impose a tax of the SH130 Municipal Management District No. 1.

HB 5667 Representative
Relating to an annual report regarding certain dog bites.

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTIONS
SECOND READING

HJR 5666 Representative
Proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature to exempt from ad valorem taxation certain real property leased to an independent school district, a junior college district, or a charter school.

HJR 5667 Representative
Proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature to provide that a school district, county, or municipality may permit an individual to provide services for or that benefit the school district, county, or municipality in lieu of paying ad valorem taxes owed to the school district, county, or municipality.

HJR 5668 Representative
Proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature to enact laws providing that the governor may, without the recommendation of the Board of Pardons and Paroles, grant clemency for a peace officer who has committed a criminal offense while performing an official duty.

HCR 5666 Representative
Recognizing that pornography is a public health hazard.

HCR 5667 Representative
Designating Palestine as the official Dogwood Capital of Texas for a 10-year period beginning in 2023.
