SJR 7000 **Creighton**

Proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing certain persons under the age of 18 to vote in a primary election.

SJR 7001 **Blanco**

Proposing a constitutional amendment establishing the Texas Redistricting Commission to redistrict the United States House of Representatives and the Texas Legislature.

SCR 7001 **Creighton**

Memorializing Congress to repeal the Protection of Lawful Commerce in Arms Act (PLCAA).

SB 7004 **Campbell**

Relating to training, preparedness, and funding for school safety and emergencies in public schools.

SB 7005 **Birdwell**

Relating to the criminal offense of hazing.

SB 7006 **Parker**

Relating to the powers and duties of the Health and Human Services Commission and the transfer to the commission of certain powers and duties from the Department of Family and Protective Services.
