SB 784 Birdwell
Relating to the exclusive jurisdiction of the state to regulate greenhouse gas emissions in this state and the express preemption of local regulation of those emissions.

SB 785 Birdwell | et al.

SB 817 Alvarado
Relating to the deadline to request a contested case hearing on an authorization to use a standard permit for a concrete plant.

SB 844 Blanco
Relating to the provision by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality of certain information in a language other than English.
